

ORDINANCE NO. 116

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE CARRYING OF CONCEALED WEAPONS IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF RICO, COLORADO, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF RICO:

SECTION 1. If any person or persons within the corporate limits of the Town of Rico, Colorado, shall wear or carry concealed upon his, her or their person, any pistol, revolver, derringer, bowie-knife, razor, dagger, slingshot or other deadly weapons, such person or persons shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall upon conviction thereof be punished by imprisonment in the county or town jail for a term not exceeding thirty days or by a fine not exceeding the sum of \$50.00 with costs, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court and in case any such fine is not paid the offender may be committed to, and confined in the county or town jail, one day for each \$2.00 of such fine, or until such fine is paid in money or by such confinement.

The foregoing provisions shall not apply to any sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, policeman or any other peace officer within his own county or when upon duty.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
