

ORDINANCE NO. 122

An Ordinance Entitled An Ordinance

CONCERNING OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE AND FIXING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Rico, Colorado.

SECTION 1. If any person maliciously or willfully disturb the peace or quiet of any person or family or assemblage of persons, by loud or unusual noises or by tumultuous or offensive carriage, threatening, traducing, quarreling, challenging to fight or fighting, within the corporate limits of the Town of Rico, or if any person shall fight, threaten or challenge to fight, or make or assist in making any improper noise or disturbance, or use profane, obscene or offensive language to any person or persons or in the presence of any person or persons, or in any public place, within the corporate limits of the Town of Rico, every person convicted thereof shall be fined in a sum of not less than Two (\$2.00) Dollars nor more that One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or be imprisoned in the Town jail not exceeding Ninety Days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, of the Town of Rico, be and the same are hereby repealed.
