ORDINANCE NO. 2001-5

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 312 CONTROL AND LICENSING OF DOGS TO
AMEND SECTION 11. B. DOG LICENSING FEES

WHEREAS the Rico Home Rule Charter §12.1 allows registered voters to propose an Ordinance to the Town Board of Trustees and such petition has been presented which meets the qualifications of §12.4, and which further requires the Town Board to either adopt this ordinance or refer this ordinance to an election;

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF RICO ORDAINS the following:

Ordinance No. 312, Section 11 Collar and Tag, paragraph B., is hereby amended to read as follows (underlined language is added, strike-out language is deleted from original ordinance):

"B. The Annual Licensing Fees are as follows:

1.	<u>First</u> Each Dog per residence	\$10.00	\$30.00
2.	Second Dog per residence	\$20.00	\$60.00
3.	Third and subsequent dogs Per residence"	\$90.00	\$90.00
