AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REFERRING A BALLOT QUESTION TO THE
NOVEMBER 4, 2003, ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Town Board has received a citizen's initiative petition that has been deemed to comply with Article XII Initiative and Referendum which requires the Board of Trustees to refer the proposed ballot measure to the registered voters of the Town of Rico;

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF RICO ORDAINS:

Section 1. Referral of Ballot Questions. The following ballot questions are hereby referred to the November 4th, 2003, general election:

TOWN OF RICO BALLOT QUESTION NO. 2.

"Shall the Board of Trustees of the Town of Rico organize and appoint a Detachment Committee to study and propose potential state legislation to detach the Rico area from the Dolores County School District and detach the Rico area from Dolores County and establish a new independent Rico County?
