

ORDINANCE NO. 276

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SEVERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF RICO.

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE

Under authority of the Colorado Revised Statutes, Section 31-16-201, et. seq., the Trustees of the Town of Rico hereby repeal in their entirety the Ordinances listed below. The Trustees have found said ordinances to be obsolete, undesirable, and/or unenforceable.
